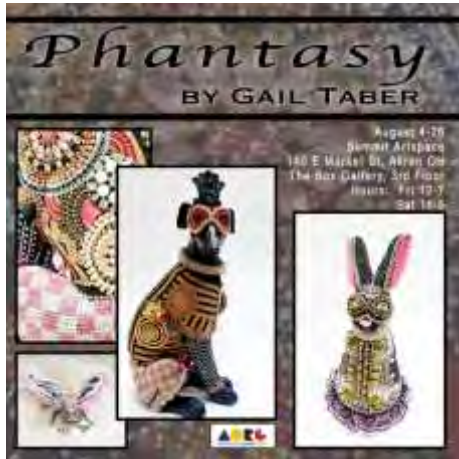

Congratulations to **Pat Waltz**, who won Best of Show in this year's May Show at the Little Art Gallery. Pat's winning entry, "Sand Hill Crane," is a 51- 1/2" sculpture with a wire armature and faux suede covering. The body is intricately hand-embroidered. The entire project, from design to finish, took 407 hours to complete over a 2 year period. Another of Pat's creations, "Blue Heron," won first place in the 3-D category several years ago in the same show. Pat likes birds, and especially enjoys creating work involving endangered animals.

Nature inspires me and my goal is to create movement and evoke an emotion when depicting my subject in a loose, expressive style.

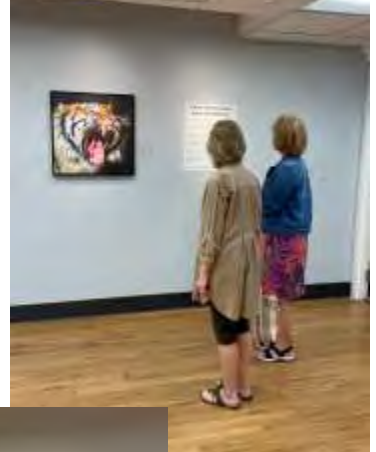
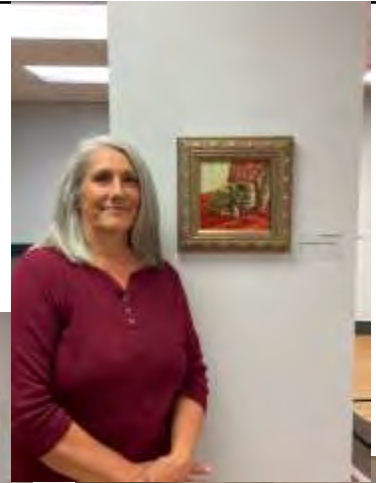
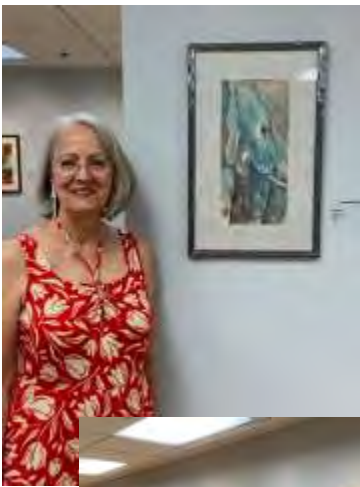
