Lori Perry - This is the second pairing I've completed in a series using old family photos. The title is Summer, 1928. Medium is liquid graphite.

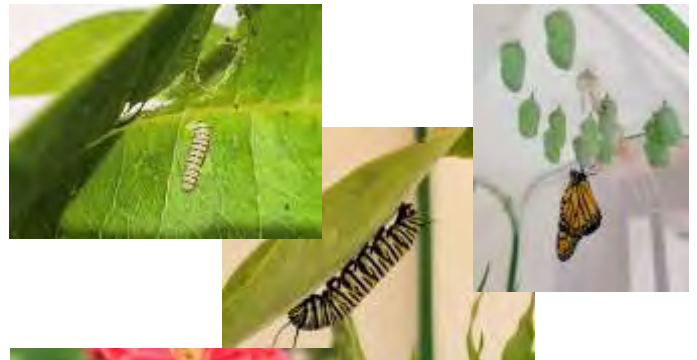
