### **Butler Institute of American Art Trip on June 24**

This juried show draws artists from around the country, and we noted how many were from Ohio. Next year, I'll watch for details and deadlines to enter – perhaps some of our stellar artists could participate. If members are interested, we would consider making this trip an ongoing event.
