

One that fascinated me was Jane Blundell, who has made a great deal of effort to create watercolor mixing charts that are over the top. On her website, [janeblundellart.com](http://janeblundellart.com) (look under resources) you can view scanned images of her multiple charts and see the thousands of possibilities. An inexpensive ebook of her charts is available. These color mixing guides should prove useful for painters in any medium. On the same website under resources, she shows color mixing possibilities in her sketchbook. I took a screenshot (which credits her website) so you can see how wonderful these resources are! For someone who can't afford to buy lots of tubes of paints, check out what she does with only four or five colors!



**Witness to Wartime: The Painted Diary of Takuichi Fujii**

April 26 - July 24, 2022

Exhibit introduces an artist whose work opens a window to historical events, issues, and ideas far greater than the individual.

Takuichi Fujii was fifty years old when war broke out between the United States and Japan. In a climate of increasing fear and racist propaganda, he became one of 100,000 people of Japanese ancestry on the West Coast forced to leave their homes and live in geographically isolated incarceration camps.



**Asian Voices from the CMA Collection**

April 26 - July 24, 2022

Juxtaposing traditional Asian subject matter with modern Western influences, this multimedia exhibition features works from contemporary Asian artists from Taiwan, Japan, and China, as well as those whose families migrated to the United States.

Storytelling through their work about their lives in America and their culture, these artists are combining past traditions and new voices in Asian art, speaking to the transnational reality of life in the twenty-first century.

Fine artist Yanay (Jana Jakesova) was born and raised in the romantic city of Prague, Czech Republic. Frequenting and living in many other great countries in Europe, she has also lived in Australia, South Africa, and the United States, which enabled her to meet many great people, and expand her world view of life in a massive way.

Yanay urges, "Do not give up! Avoid critics who themselves cannot paint! Listen only to constructive critics; those expert in the great artists who may actually show you how to improve. Educate yourself regarding the techniques, but find your own way to express yourself. Do not agree with invalidation for example; that you are not so genial or great as Leonardo da Vinci; so you should find a better way to make a living! The main thing is to have your own confidence in your own creations, and to have something to communicate to the world. Art comes from an impulse inside the artist, despite all obstacles!"
